Rev. Jacob A. Hunter

The Rev. Jacob A. Hunter, 79, of McComb died June 21, 1988, in Field Memorial Community Hospital in Centreville. Visitation will be 7-9 p.m. Sunday in Craft's Funeral Home chapel of McComb, and services will be 11 a.m. Monday in Christ Temple Church of Christ Holiness of McComb with Bishop M.D. Bingham officiating. Burial will be in Greenwood North Cemetery in McComb.
